Thank you very much for trusting me with your personal data. I declare that I protect your personal data in accordance with all applicable legislation, including the GDPR regulation.

You provide your personal data voluntarily by filling out the registration form or purchasing the BE a Woman application.

What Personal Data Do I Process and for What Purpose?

****Email Address:**** To ensure the correct functioning of the BE a Woman application, I need your email address solely for purposes required by the application. I will only send you emails if they provide valuable information regarding the BE a Woman application. You can unsubscribe at any time by clicking the "unsubscribe" button.

****Billing Information:**** If you are interested in a paid membership in the application, I need your mailing address (billing information) to comply with legal obligations for issuing and recording tax documents.

****Cookies:**** When visiting my website, your IP address is recorded. If cookies are enabled in your browser, information about the pages you visit is collected using cookies. I use the Google Analytics service on the website. You can find details about it directly on Google's website.

If I need your consent to process certain personal data for specific purposes, I will only process such data with your consent. You can browse the website in a mode that does not allow personal data collection. You may choose to enable or disable cookies on your device.

I retain your personal data for the duration of the applicable statutory limitation periods unless the law requires a longer retention period or I have stated otherwise in specific cases.

****Data Security and Protection****

I protect personal data using modern technologies that comply with a high level of technical development. I have adopted and maintain almost all currently known technical and organizational measures to prevent misuse, damage, or destruction of your personal data.

****Sharing of Personal Data with Third Parties****

Your data is accessible only to cooperating accountants, financial institutions, data storage and software application providers, goods carriers, cooperating individuals and legal entities responsible for managing websites and software applications, or performing technical, organizational, operational, administrative, logistical, or other relevant tasks.

I enter into contracts with processors, ensuring they fulfill their obligations concerning data protection, keeping your data secure. All global technology providers (data storage, social networks, software, etc.) with whom it is technically impossible to enter into a separate processing contract are committed to meeting all GDPR requirements on their side and fully ensuring the protection of all personal data, including the data I manage.

In exceptional cases, I am required to disclose personal data to relevant administrative authorities if such an obligation is imposed by law (e.g., during inspections where such authorities are authorized to request the submission of personal data).

Data processing is conducted exclusively within the European Union.

****Your Rights Regarding Personal Data Protection****

****Right to Information:**** This is fulfilled by this information page detailing personal data processing principles.

****Right of Access:**** You can request information at any time, and I will provide documentation within 30 days about what personal data I process and why.

****Right to Rectification:**** If something changes or you find your personal data outdated or incomplete, you have the right to update and correct it.

****Right to Restrict Processing:**** You can use this right if you believe your data is inaccurate, suspect illegal processing, but do not want all data deleted, or if you have raised an objection to processing. You can restrict the scope of personal data or the purpose of processing (e.g., unsubscribing from newsletters limits processing for sending business communications).

****Right to Data Portability:**** If you want to transfer your personal data to someone else, I will proceed the same way as with the right of access, but provide the data in a machine-readable format. This process may take up to 30 days.

****Right to Erasure (Right to Be Forgotten):**** You have the right to be forgotten. Upon your request, I will delete all your personal data from my systems and those of any processors and backups. Ensuring the right to erasure may take up to 30 days.

In some cases, I am bound by legal obligations (e.g., tax document retention for a statutory period). In such cases, I will delete only the personal data not bound by other legal requirements.

****Complaint to the Data Protection Authority****

If you believe that I am not handling your data lawfully, you have the right to file a complaint with the Data Protection Authority. However, I would appreciate it if you informed me first so that I can address the issue and rectify any potential shortcomings.

****Confidentiality****

Rest assured that both I and any collaborators processing your personal data are bound by confidentiality obligations. This confidentiality extends beyond the termination of contractual relationships with me. Your personal data will not be disclosed to any third party without your consent.

These personal data processing principles have been effective since May 25, 2018, and replace the previous Privacy Policy.
